



## Michawana RV Campground A Christian Family Adventure Center

**WELCOME TO CAMP MICHAWANA! Thank you for choosing to be our guest. It is our desire to make your stay a delightful and memorable experience so you will want to come again. Telling your friends about Michawana will be our biggest compliment.**

It is an honor to be stewards of these beautiful facilities and we hope that you are blessed by using them. Michawana is a family campground; by adhering to these guidelines you will help us to maintain a positive family atmosphere. Please inform all members of your group of these guidelines.

- Check-in is 3:00 PM and check-out is 2:00 PM for RV Sites. Check-out is at 1:00 PM for the cabins.
- Quiet hours are observed from **11:00 PM until 8:00 AM daily**.
- For the safety of all of our guests, especially children, please observe our **10 MPH Speed Limit** at all times.
- **Smoking is not permitted** in buildings or around children. We also ask that you **refrain from using profanity, drugs, and alcohol on Michawana grounds**.
- One family unit per site. **Children must be under adult supervision at all times**. As per the State of Michigan Law, there is a maximum of 8 persons per campsite.
- **Firewood may not be brought onto the grounds**. Firewood is available at the RV office for \$1 per bundle. Please use designated fire pits only. **Fire pits are for wood, not trash**. Please do not cut Michawana trees for campfires.
- The RV pavilion is available for your use unless otherwise reserved. Please leave the pavilion as you found it. Exclusive use of the pavilion is by prior arrangement only. See office for details.
- **Golf Carts, ATV's, mopeds, and motorized scooters are not permitted**. Special medical needs are considered. Limit 2 cars per campsite. Extra vehicle, trailer & equipment parking is available. Bikes are welcome.
- Please **return picnic tables to cement pad** and deposit bagged trash in the dumpster upon departure. The dump station is available for your use.
- Please maintain modest attire both at the campground and the waterfront. **Modest one piece swim suits** are required or wear a T-shirt over two piece or revealing suits (not white please!).
- The waterfront is open to RV Campers at any time; however, campers swim at their own risk when a Michawana Lifeguard is not on duty. All equipment at the waterfront **MAY NOT** be used unless lifeguards are on duty according to Michigan State Law. An adult must accompany all children under the age of 18 to the waterfront at all times. You are responsible for the safety of yourself and others in your group. Michawana Lifeguards are in charge of the waterfront and all rules must be followed.
- There is a maximum of 2 quiet pets per site. Pets must remain on a 6 foot leash and under supervision at all times. They are **not permitted in any building or cabin**. If your pet is being a disturbance to other campers you may be asked to leave. Per state requirements pets are not allowed on the beach.
- In case of severe weather Camp Staff will make every effort to notify guests. The RV bathhouse and other block construction restrooms on the property are available for protection. Please see reverse side for more emergency information.
- A deposit of 1 night's stay is required to at the time of booking. Your deposit is refundable up to 2 weeks before your scheduled arrival. If you cancel with less than 2 weeks' notice your deposit is nonrefundable, but transferable to a later date within the same camping season.
- **Please report all damage or hazards to the RV Campground office or call 269-623-3035.**
